These deceptions are completely idolised and I **LOVE** it.


You can feel apart of something that takes you away from the harsh realities of the world and tap into this delicate and girly persona.

Femininity is something that can belong to anyone and it is powerful if embraced, femininity is not a weakness but instead a strength.










How would you define femininity?
