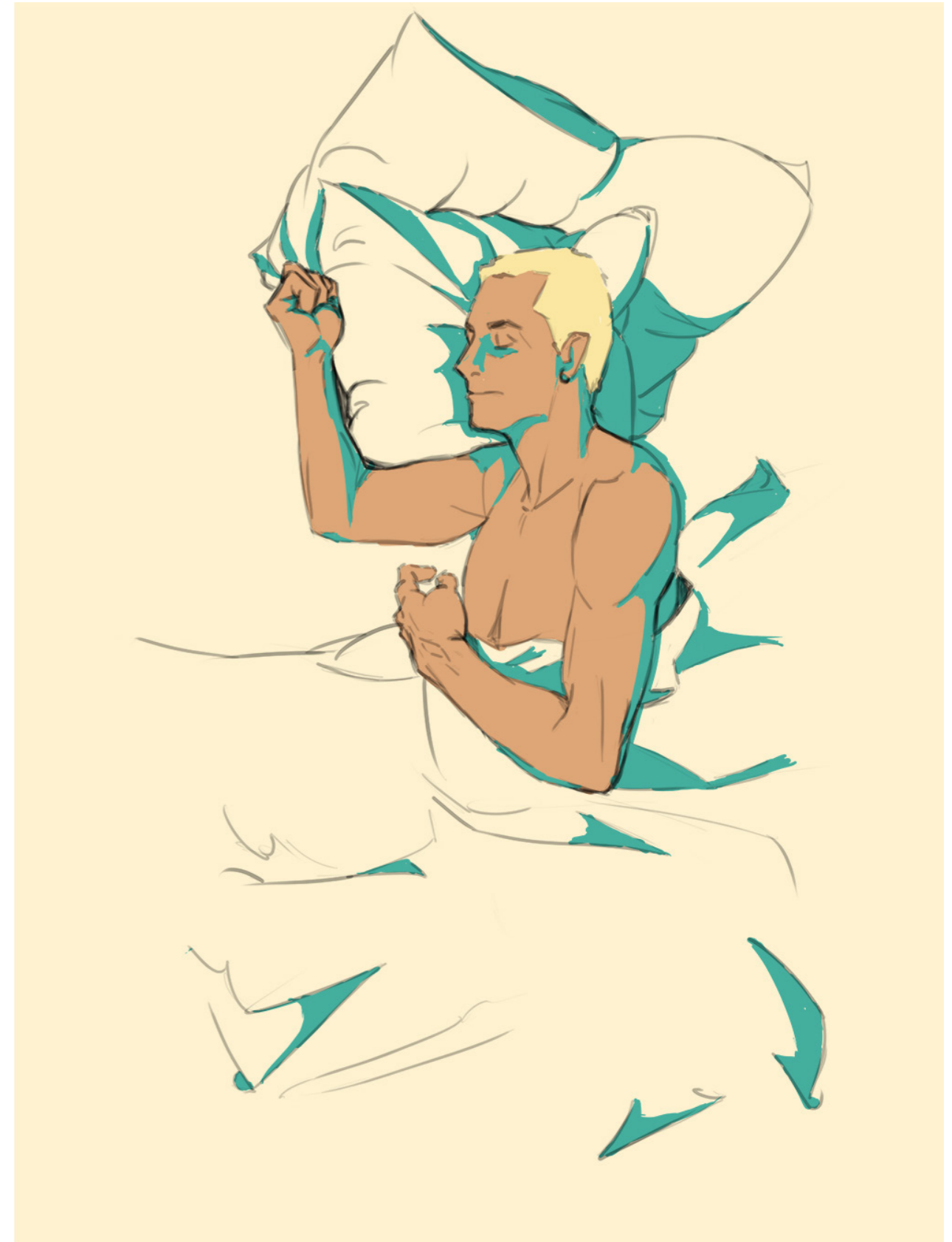
How do we perceive intimacy and the concept of romance?
