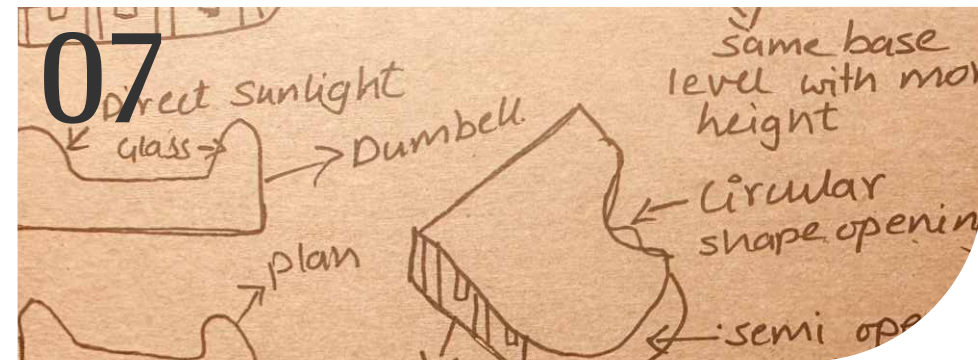
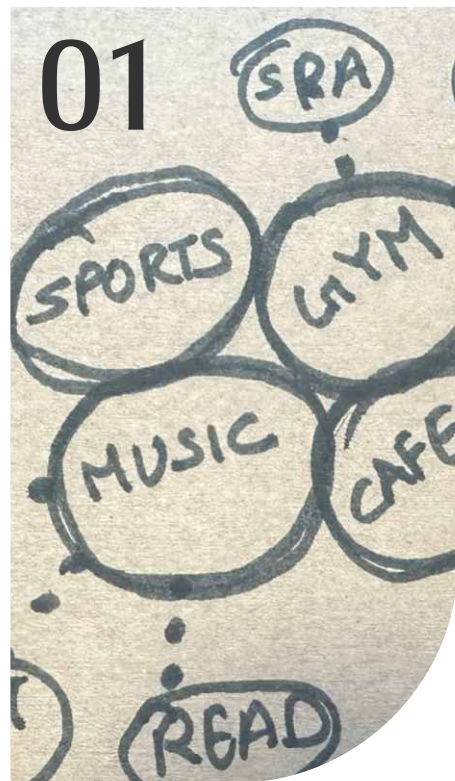

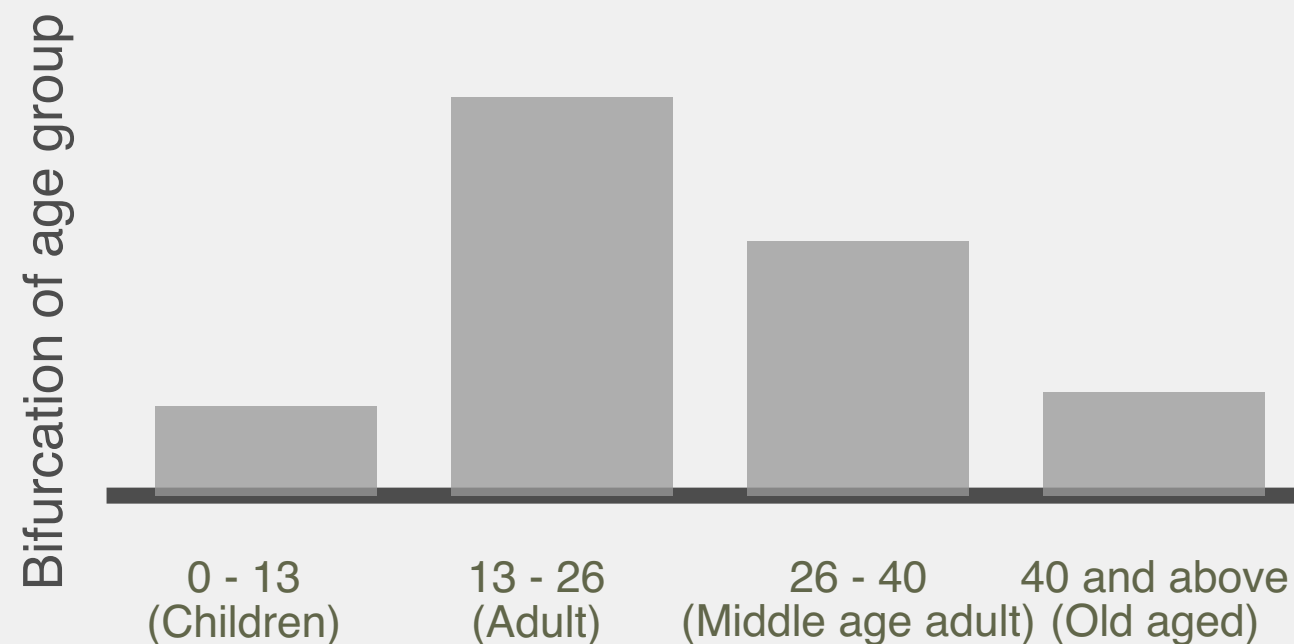
Culture

Challenges students face in life Journey

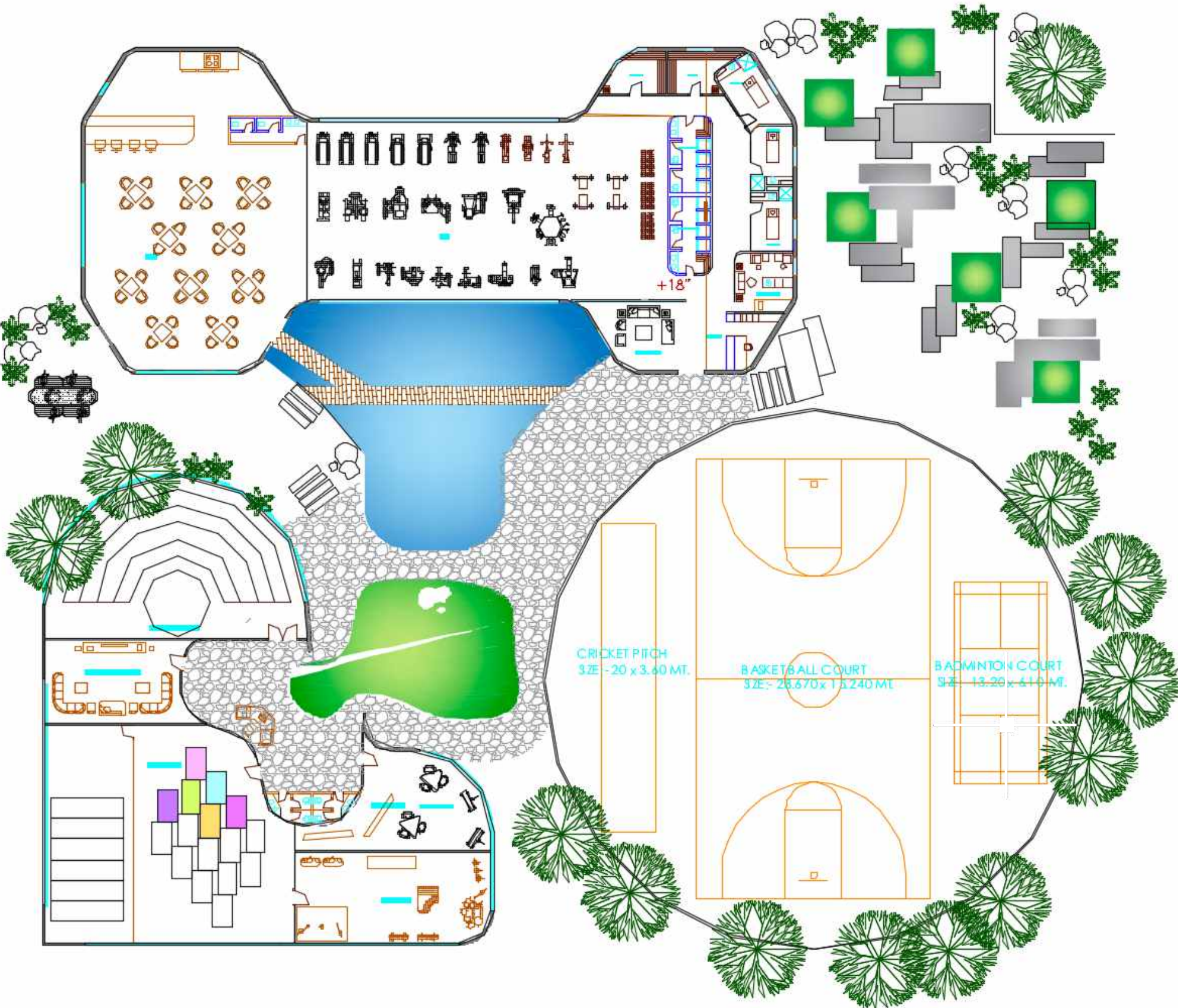
The site is near from 8-9 educational hub so that student can have easy access to go on leisure time.

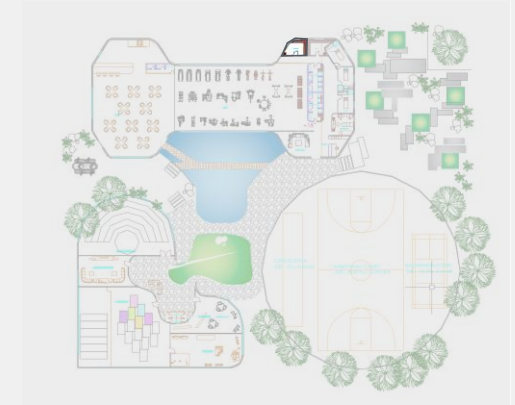
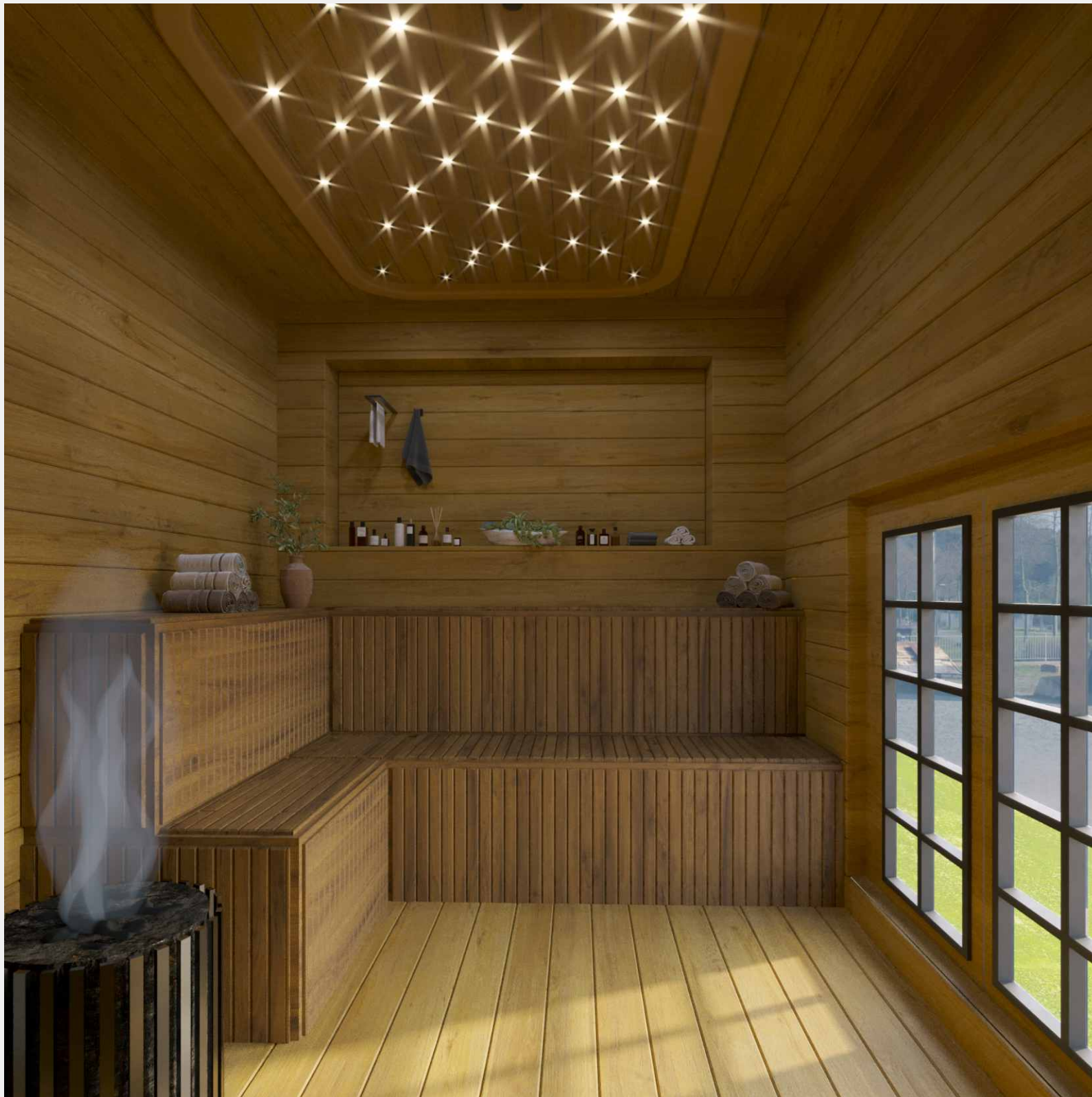


Gym

I've created a gym that students may use to exercise and remain in shape while also realising the metal streets of the day.



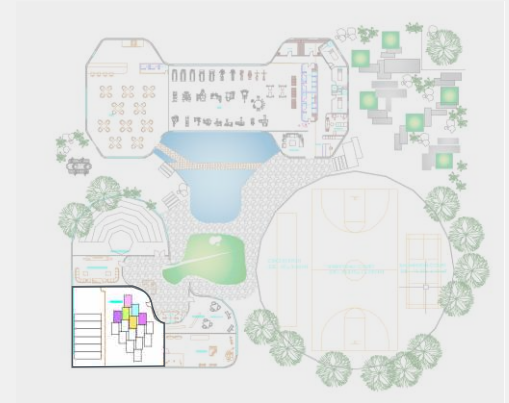
Sauna (Gym)



Material use for designing sauna space is local plywood.

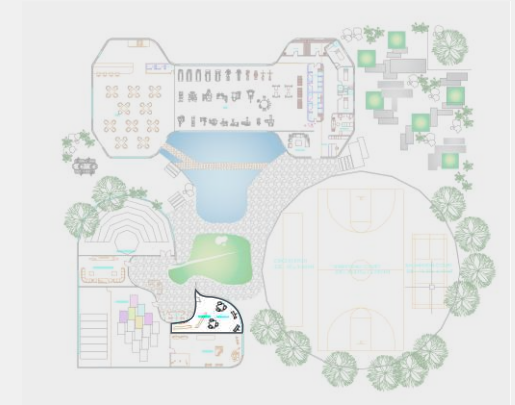

Dance Studio



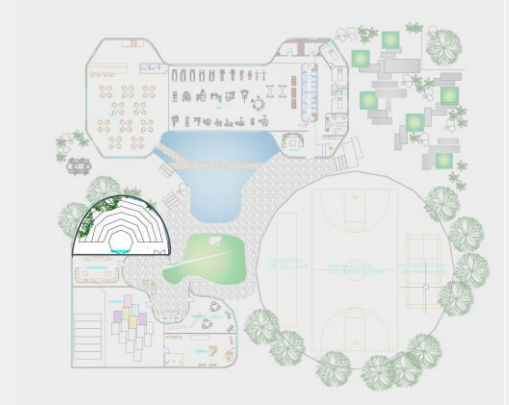

Painting and Reading room



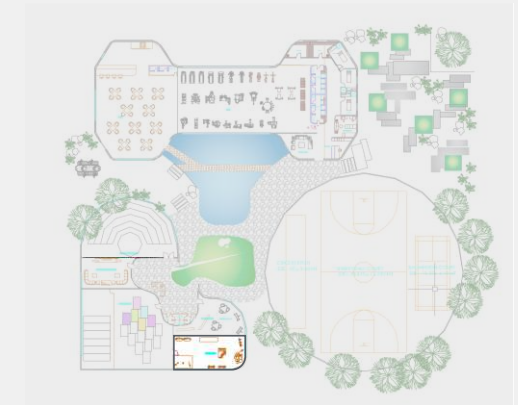
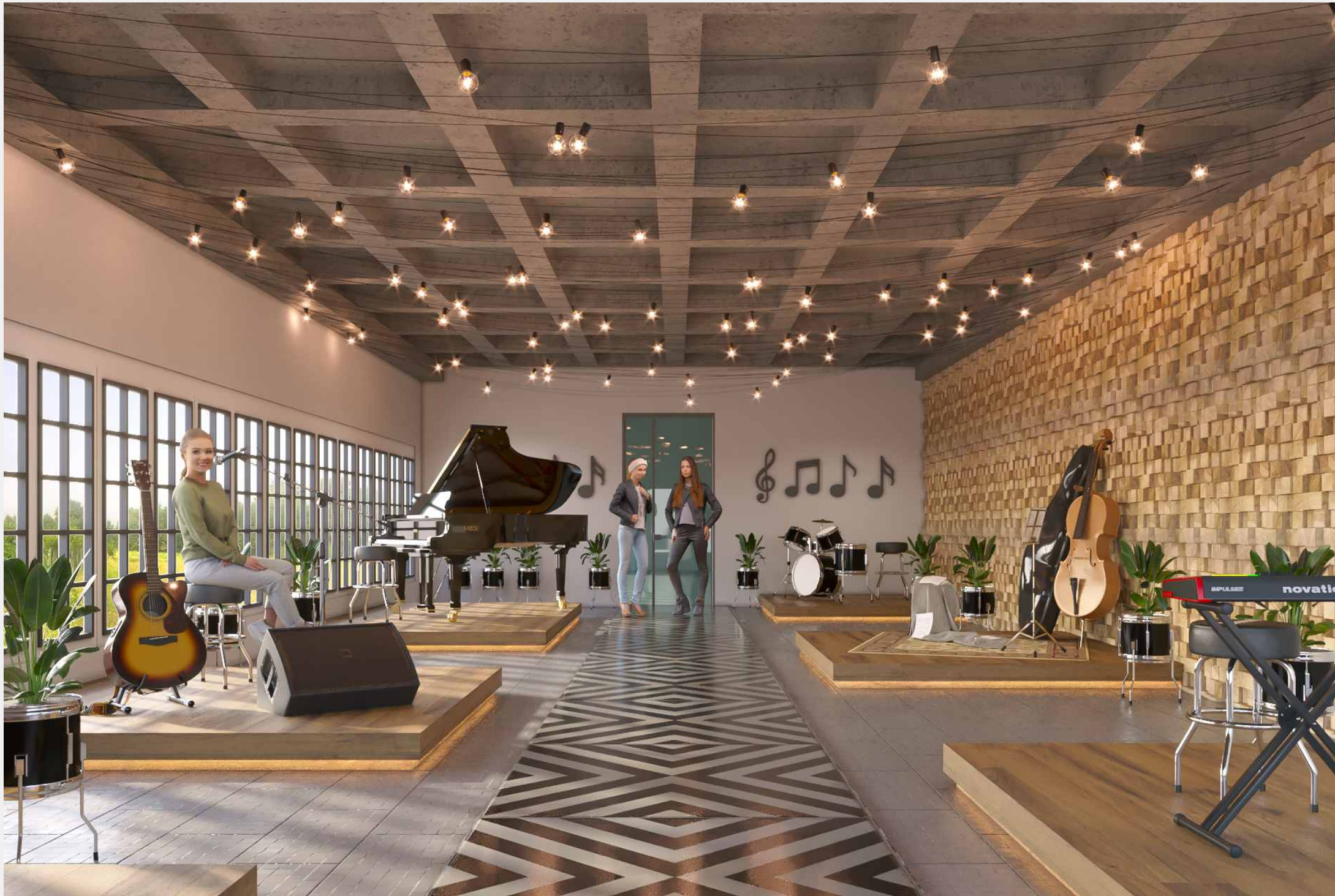

Karaoke Room

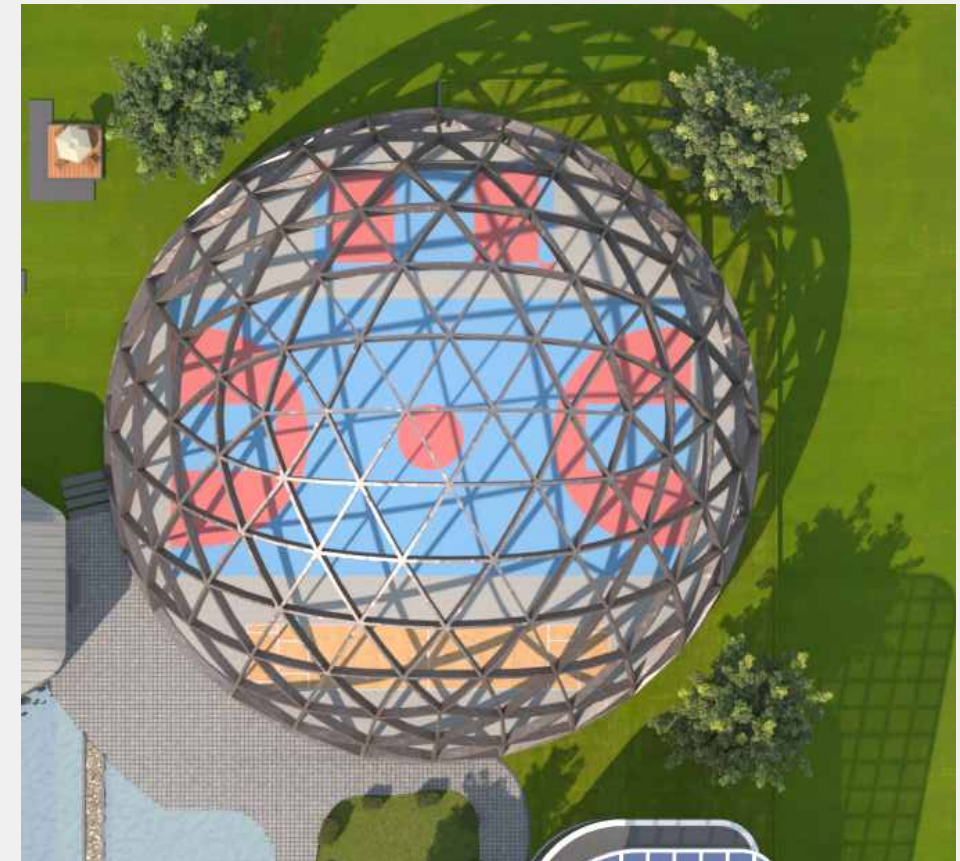


karaoke room is the space where friends get together and allowing people to sing along with music using a microphone and lyrics displayed on a screen.

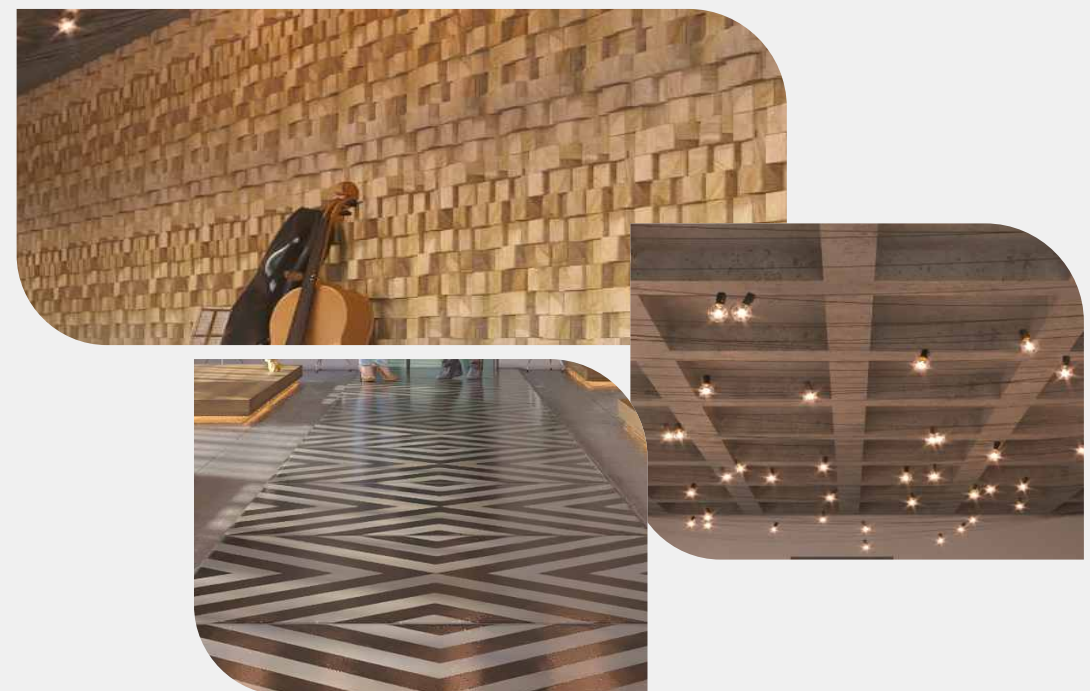

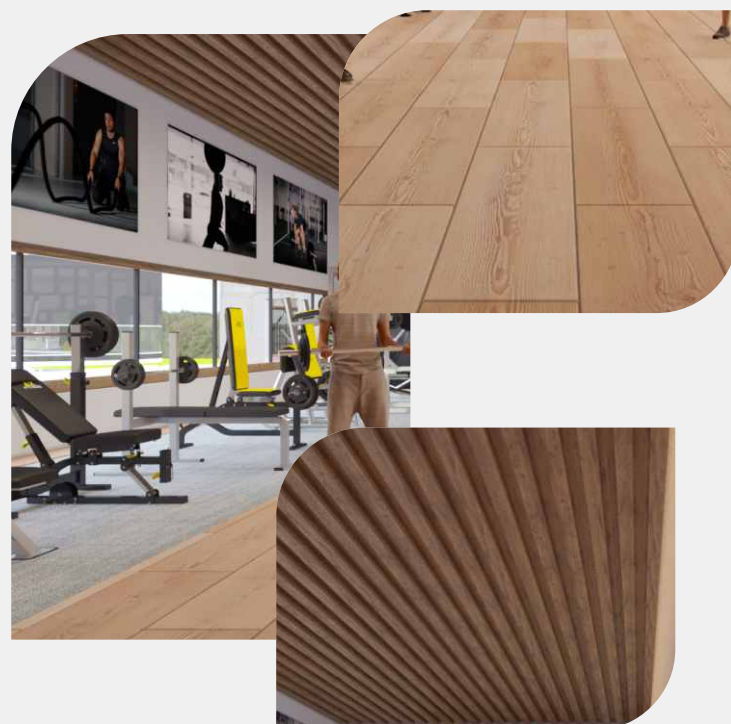
