

Card Game Instructions



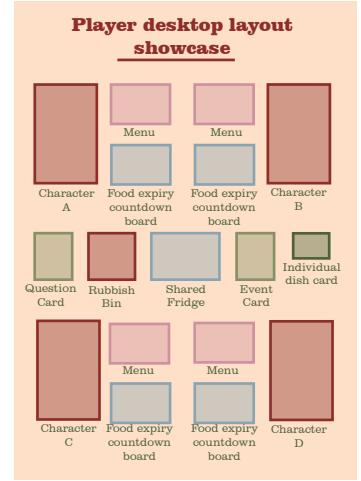
Game preparation

Suggested number of players: 2-4
 Game time: 30-60 minutes
 How to win the game: The person with the most points wins

Accessory Contents

Character cards: 4 sheets
 Event cards: 30 cards
 Question cards: 10 pieces
 Ingredient cards: 100 sheets
 Individual dish card: 70 sheets
 Recipe cards: 4 sheets
 Refrigerator card: 1 piece
 Bin assembly: 4 acrylic plates + 1 wooden plate

Food expiry countdown board: 4
 Game instructions: 1 book



Character card

In rock-paper-scissors order, the winner draws a card first.

Each player then draws a character card from that side without seeing the chosen country.

After all four players have chosen a character card, they reveal their cards to see their assigned roles.

Main character card description

Upon revealing the cards, each player will discover that each character card represents a country. If a player chooses a dish from the same country as their character card, they earn an additional 3 points per dish.

Question card & Event card

Then the game officially began, a total of 5 games cooking competition, according to the previous rock-paper-scissors order of the winner first to take the first game of the question card.

Followed by each game from the win plus the left-hand side of the player to start, each game to draw a question card as the authorities of the dish requirements.

After drawing the question card, flip it over as the title requirement for this round's dish.

Again, start with the winner of the previous round of rock-paper-scissors. In the same order as before, each round begins with each person drawing an event card first. Each round starts with the person who drew the question card first drawing the event card, which contains a variety of random events that players must experience before going to the ingredient.

There are 5 games in total, one question card per game, and then one event card for each player.

After completing the requirements of the event card, take the ingredients, you need to cook according to the recipe, each person can only take a maximum of 5 ingredient cards per game, which can be used as a source of ingredients for this game, but also for the next game's dish preparation.

Each person can only cook one dish in one game.

Each ingredient card corresponds to a different shelf life on top, from 0-4, with 0 being the ingredient that the authorities are about to use, and 4 being the 4th game after you get the ingredient as the final use-by date.

Food expiry countdown board

The numbers on the board represent a 5-inning game, where ingredients are inserted into the corresponding compartments according to their shelf life based on the number of innings.

Before the start of the next game, move your ingredient shelf life forward 1 space and throw away any ingredients that have expired.

Menu

The following dishes need to be made according to the ingredients above, and the numbers below correspond to the ingredients above.

Individual dish card

Players can collect all the ingredients needed for a dish to redeem the corresponding dish card, while used ingredients need to be thrown into the rubbish bin.

Positive, the look of the dish

On the reverse side of each card there is a score, which is determined by the number of ingredients needed.

4 points

On the flip side, the score obtained for this dish

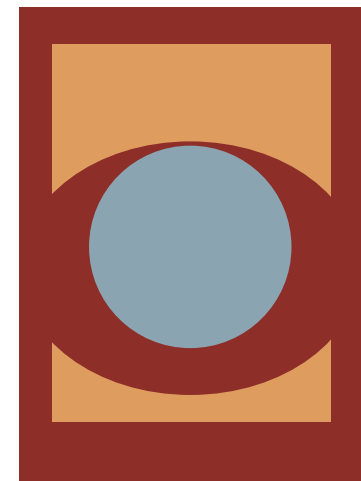
Shared fridge

The maximum number of ingredients that can be placed on the fridge card is 6. When an ingredient is placed in the fridge to take a moment, the shelf life of the ingredient will not count down until it is taken out of the fridge.

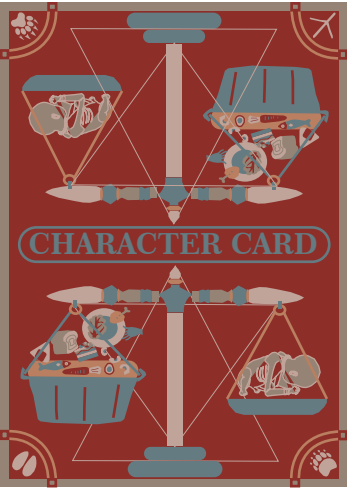
For example, if an ingredient with a total of 1 game of shelf life left is placed in the fridge, no matter how many games have been played, taking it out of the fridge will still leave 1 game of shelf life left.

Photo of ingredients placed on top of the fridge card

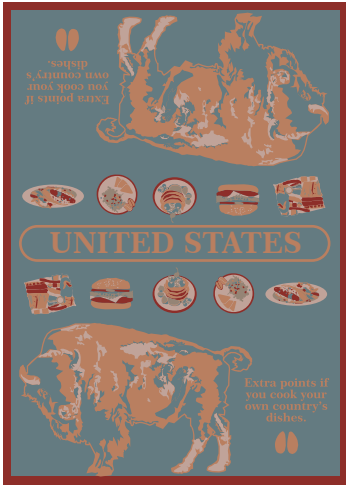
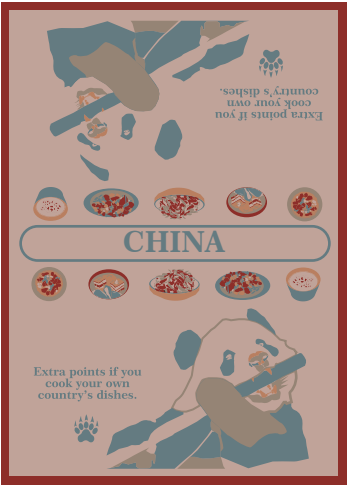

Back Of The Card

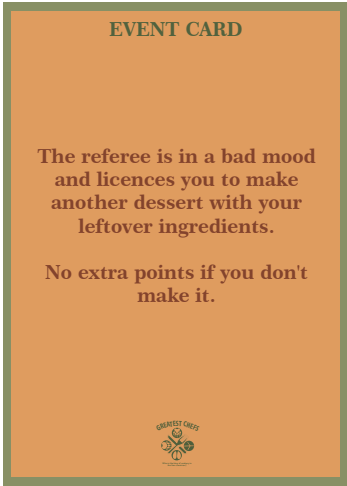
Card Front

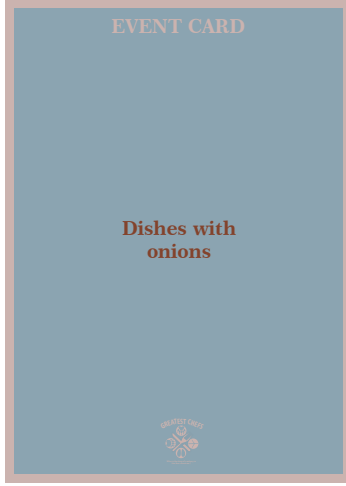

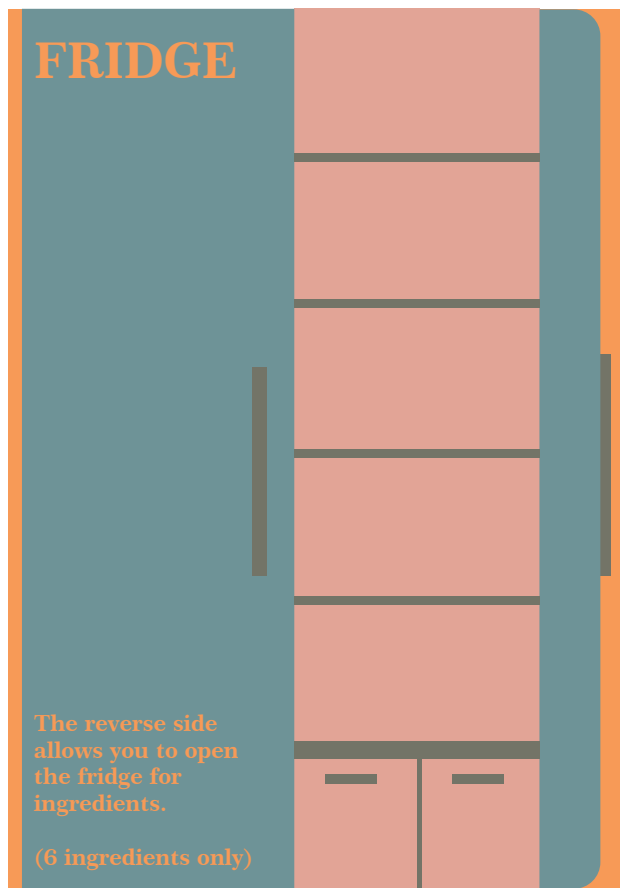
Question Card

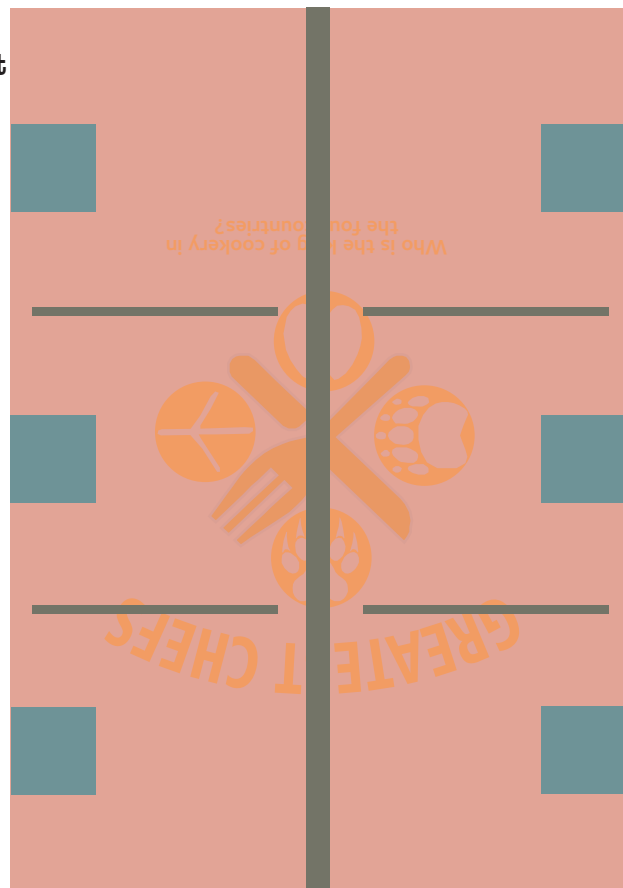


Fridge Card

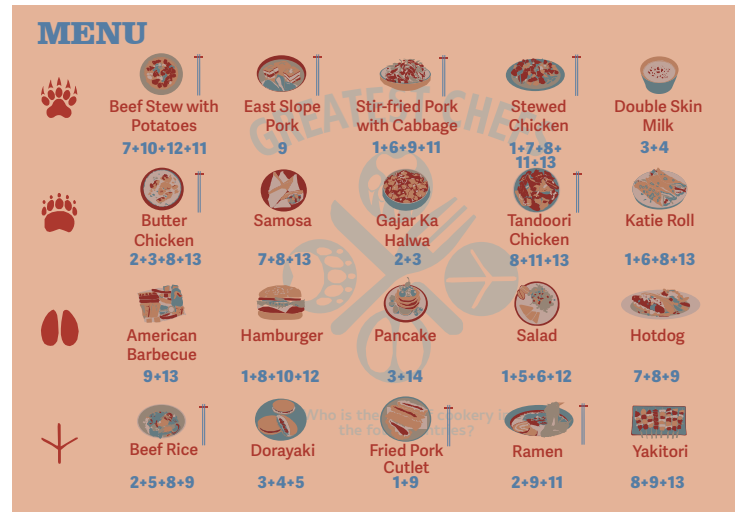


Menu Card

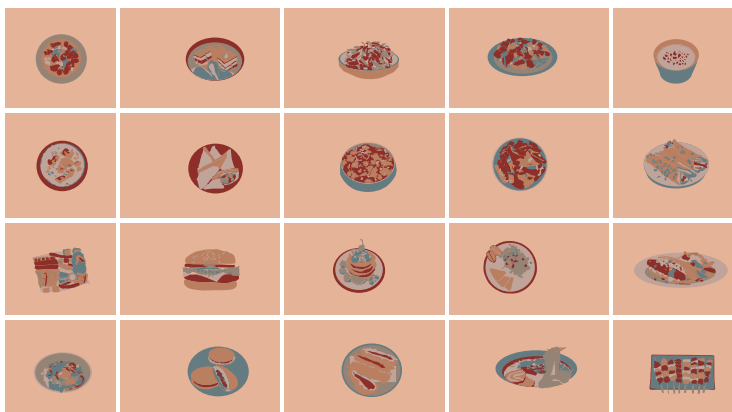

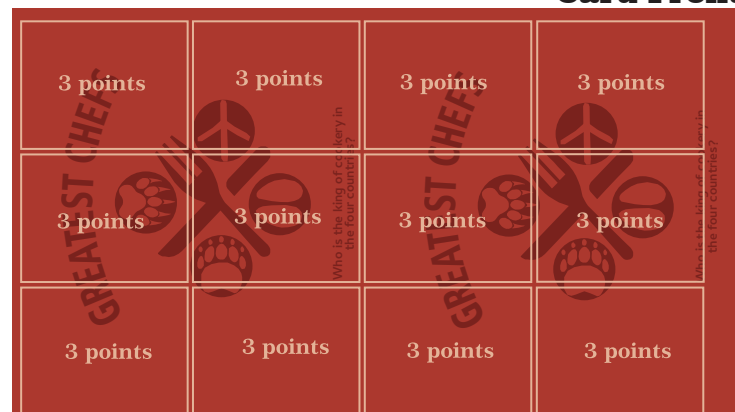
