





Tulle fabric provides volume for skirts. I prefer natural stiffness for my ball gown silhouette, and using net fabric decreases the garment's weight while nylon or polyester net adds a fluffy look



Single edge stitching method ruffles. Long stitch for less fullness, shorter stitch for more fullness




Mock pin tucking stitched with a twin needle and a grooved pin-tuck foot.







After creating the initial calico sample of the corset, it became apparent that some changes needed to be made to improve the shape and patterns. There were also issues with the overbust cup measurement. Despite the corset appearing to be a simple garment to make, I soon realized that it requires a great deal of precision throughout the entire process. Even a small mistake could ruin the final outcome.











The process of creating the fishtail skirt pattern involved adapting a basic body pattern. The upper layer of the skirt starts from the high waist, while the lower panel is meticulously constructed by dividing the bodice patterns into five separate pieces, resulting in the distinctive fishtail shape.
